<p>A small tube that connects your middle ear to the nasopharynx. It helps to keep the pressure equal on both sides of the ear drum.</p>	<p>Three semicircular shaped tubes that are located in the inner ear. They help the body with coordination and balance.</p>	<p>A snail shaped tube located in the inner ear that contains hair cells which help transmit sounds to the brain.</p>
